Oak, Bur	Slow	70-90 ft	8-20 ft x 16 ft	Partial shade	Sand-clay	Sturdy, long lasting tree, good for wildlife, will tolerate wetter site conditions.
Poplar, Siouxland	Fast	70-90 ft	8-20 ft x 16 ft	Full sun	Sandy loam-clay, dry-wet soils	Fast growing with a medium life expectancy, shallow rooted, seedless cottonwood.

Pine, Jack	Fast	25-60 ft	6-10 ft x 16 ft	Full sun	Sand-sandy loam, dry-moist soils	Good for wildlife, may be browsed by deer, tolerates dry, sandy soils.
Pine, Norway	Fast	75-100 ft	8-16 ft x 20 ft	Full-partial sun	Sand-silty clay, dry-moist soils	Does better in sandy loam sites. Salt intolerant. Deer browse is a moderate issue.
Pine, White	Fast	50-80 ft	8-16 ft x 20 ft	Full sun-partial shade	Loamy sand-clay loam, dry-moist soils	Excellent timber tree, soft needles, deer browse protection is a must, beautiful tree that's worth the effort.
Spruce, Black	Slow	30-60 ft	6-10 ft x 16 ft	Full-partial sun	Sand-clay.	Can tolerate very wet sites. Grows faster in well drained soils. Native to swamps.
Spruce, Norway (plugs)	Fast	40-100 ft	8-16 ft x 20 ft	Full sun	Sandy loam-clay	Large, fast growing spruce. Produces large cones. Not susceptible to deer browse.
Spruce, White	Moderate	40-60 ft	8-16 ft x 20 ft	Full sun-shade	Loam-clay, moist-wet soils	Windbreak tree, suits many sites.
Tamarack (Larch)	Fast	40-80 ft	6-10 ft x 16 ft	Full sun	Sand-clay, dry-wet soils	Beautiful fall color, fast grower and long lived.
