§103F.48 RIPARIAN PROTECTION AND WATER QUALITY PRACTICES

1. COMPLIANCE TRACKING OF ALL PARCELS SUBJECT TO THE BUFFER LAW

All parcels in the county are to be reviewed within a 3 year timeframe. The SWCD plans to review a minimum of 1/3 of the parcels in the County every year. See the Buffer Compliance Plan Map for monitoring regions.

2. RANDOM SPOT CHECKS

Random spot checks will be done in addition to the tracking of all parcels within a 3 year span. These checks may be conducted via aerial photo review or on-site review depending on availability and applicability of updated aerial photos. A combination of both aerial and on-site review may also be used.

The SWCD will conduct a random spot check on a minimum of 25 parcels each year outside of the scheduled area.
