More About The SWCD Annual Tree Sale Program

Tree distribution dates: Trees will be available for pick-up in Baudette in early May. You will be notified approximately one month in advance for times, dates and location for pickup. Arrangements for cold, long-term storage must be made ***in advance***.

Quantities are limited, orders accepted until stock is depleted. Refunds only if desired trees are unavailable. Size may vary depending on nursery availability.

The SWCD is not responsible for tree survival or replacement. Due to the perishable nature of tree seedlings, we cannot guarantee survivability or replacement. Tree seedlings must be kept in a cool, moist environment until planted.

Chokecherry, Common	Fast	10-20 ft	3-8 ft x 10 ft	Full sun-partial shade	Sandy loam-silty clay, dry-wet soils	Good for pollinators and wildlife. Edible berries. Not heavily browsed.
Cranberry, Highbush	Moderate	8-12 ft	3-8 ft x 10 ft	Full sun-shade	Sandy loam-clay, moist to wet soils	Tolerates wet soils, berry producing, can be planted in hedges.
Dogwood, Redosier	Fast	6-12 ft	3-8 ft x 10 ft	Full sun	Sand-clay, moist-wet soils	White berries, pretty red bark, can be pruned.
Lilac, Common Purple	Moderate	10-15 ft	3-8 ft x 10 ft	Full sun	Sandy loam-clay loam, moist-wet soils	Suckers freely, can be pruned, good for hedges, low wildlife rating
Nannyberry	Moderate	15-18 ft	3-8 ft x 10 ft	Full sun-shade	Sandy loam-silty loam, dry-wet soils	Purple fall foliage. Berry producer, good for pollinators. Native to the region.
Plum, American	Moderate	10-15 ft	3-8 ft x 10 ft	Full sun	Loamy sand-silty clay, dry-wet soils	White flowers, edible plums, forms a thicket.
Serviceberry (Juneberry)	Moderate	4-6 ft	3-8 ft x 10 ft	Full—partial sun	Sand to sandy clay, dry-wet soils	Sweet fruit good for eating and jelly. Makes a good hedge

Birch, Paper	Moderate	50-70 ft	8-20 ft x 16 ft	Full—partial sun	Sand-silty clay, moist-wet soils	Needs protection from deer, moderate habitat benefits.
Maple, Silver	Fast	60-80 ft	8-20 ft x 16 ft	Full—partial sun	Sandy loam-silty clay, moist-wet soils	Large, flood tolerant tree.
Oak, Bur	Slow	60-100 ft	8-20 ft x 16 ft	Partial shade	Sand-clay, dry-wet soils	Sturdy, long lasting tree, good for wildlife, will tolerate wetter site conditions.

Pine, Jack	Fast	50-65 ft	6-10 ft x 16 ft	Full sun	Sand-sandy loam, dry-moist soils	Used for shelterbelts and reforestation, native tree that can tolerate drought
Pine, Red (Norway)	Fast	75-100 ft	8-16 ft x 20 ft	Full-partial sun	Sand-silty clay, dry-moist soils	Does better in sandy loam sites. Salt intolerant. Deer browse is a moderate issue.
Pine, White	Fast	75-100 ft	8-16 ft x 20 ft	Full sun-partial shade	Loamy sand-clay loam, dry-moist soils	Excellent timber tree, soft needles, deer browse protection is a must, beautiful tree that's worth the effort.
Spruce, White	Moderate	50-75 ft	8-16 ft x 20 ft	Full sun-shade	Loam-clay, moist-wet soils	Windbreak tree, suits many sites.
Tamarack	Fast	40-80 ft	6-10 ft x 16 ft	Full sun	Sand-clay, dry-wet soils	Beautiful fall color, fast grower, loses its needles in the fall.
